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Rotary Youth Leadership Award Code of Conduct

1. Attendance at all sessions is compulsory.
2. Sleeping quarters allocated to females and males are out of bounds to the opposite sex.
3. Smoking is not permitted in dormitories, community hall, and seminar room or in toilet / shower blocks.
4. Alcohol or illegal drugs are not permitted at all, under any circumstances, within the seminar centre or on the grounds of Blue Gum Lodge. This is a condition of use of Blue Gum Lodge applied by the Anglican Diocese of Sydney, owners of the property.
5. Awardees may not make arrangements to leave the seminar during the week (except for essential purposes such as job interviews or university enrolment). The Seminar Director must be consulted in advance before Awardees may leave Blue Gum Lodge.
6. Private motor vehicles of Awardees are not permitted at the Centre.
7. It is in the interest of all Awardees that no visitors be invited to the Centre during the week.
8. Mobile phones and pagers are banned from all seminar sessions and meals.
